澤目 梢（Kozue Sawame）在性別議題及女性領導方面擁有 20 多年的經驗，專注於美國和日本慈善事業、非營利組織以及女性創業。目前是 Fish Family Foundation 的 JWLI（日本女性領導力倡議）總裁，該基金會是位於波士頓的私人家族基金會，在東京設有衛星辦公室。她負責監督 JWLI（由四個女性領導力計畫組成的項目），該項目是日本領先的社會企業精神及創新計畫之一，也是關注女性及女性領導的社會變革先驅。她是 AVPN（亞洲創業慈善網路）亞洲性別網路成員，特別是在他們倡導的「性別視角捐贈原則（Gender Lens Giving Principles）」方面。她曾在亞洲性別平等基金（2,500 萬美元）及亞洲青年心理健康基金（300 萬美元）的 AVPN 資助審查委員會任職。此前，她曾在總部位於波士頓的非營利組織 ATASK（亞洲反家庭暴力工作小組）領導募款活動，為家庭暴力倖存者提供服務。她獲得喬治城大學（Georgetown University）的碩士學位。美國 - 日本基金會的 USJLP 代表，並且是巴布森學院（Babson College）及東西方中心（East-West Center）的課程畢業生。她在北海道出生長大，目前居住在波士頓。

Kozue Sawame has 20+ years of experience in gender issues and women's leadership with concentrations on philanthropy, nonprofits, and women's entrepreneurship in the U.S. and Japan. Currently, Kozue is the President of JWLI (Japanese Women's Leadership Initiative) at the Fish Family Foundation, a private family foundation in Boston with a satellite office in Tokyo. Kozue oversees JWLI - a collection of four women's leadership programs - that is among the leading social entrepreneurship and innovation programs in Japan and is a pioneer focused on women and woman-led social change. Kozue is a member of the Asia Gender Network of AVPN (Asia Venture Philanthropy Network), particularly in their initiative of the Gender Lens Giving Principles. She has served on AVPN's grant review committees for the Asia Gender Equality Fund (\$25 million) and the Asian Youth Mental Wellbeing Fund (\$3 million). Previously, Kozue led fundraising at ATASK (Asian Task Force Against Domestic Violence), a Boston-based nonprofit serving domestic violence survivors. Kozue received her master's degree from Georgetown University. She is a USJLP delegate of the U.S.-Japan Foundation, and a program graduate of Babson College and the East-West Center. She was born and raised in Hokkaido and currently lives in Boston.

Chang-Ling Huang is a professor of political science in the National Taiwan University. Her research specialties are comparative politics and gender politics, and her research focuses on women's political participation, state feminism, and state-society relations. Professor Huang was a board member and the president of the Awakening Foundation, the earliest established feminist organization in post-war Taiwan. She has also served as the president of the Taiwanese Feminist Scholars Association and the president of the Taiwan Association for Truth and Reconciliation. Besides participating in the NGOs, She was a civic member of the cabinet gender equality commission and was a member of the gender equality task force of the Ministry of Interior and the Ministry of Law.

She has participated in advocacy efforts for the promotion of gender equality in marriage and family, as well as the same-sex marriage movement. In addition, she has contributed to the reform and research of positive consent related to bodily autonomy in sexual interactions. Ms. Chin is devoted to the reform of legal systems and measures for the prevention and control of gender-based violence, focusing mainly on sexual harassment and digital sexual violence.

She previously served as a Visiting Associate Professor at The Open University of Japan Okinawa Study Centre and as the Lifelong Learning Promotion Section Chief at the Okinawa Prefectural Education Center. Additionally, she has held positions as an Elementary School Principal, Instructional Director at the Okinawa Prefectural Library, and Instructional Director at the Okinawa Prefecture Comprehensive Education Center. Ms. Kurane was a member of the Okinawa Prefectural Board of Education from January 2020 to December 2023.

Joyce Teng is the Executive Director of Taiwan Equality Campaign (previously known as "Marriage Equality Coalition Taiwan".) Recently she become a Hillary Rodham Clinton Fellow on Gender Equity at Georgetown Institute for Women Peace and Security (GIWPS). She is also a lecturer at Tokyo Institute of Technology and Hosei University in Tokyo. She holds a PhD in Area Studies from Sophia University, Tokyo and a Master of Theological Studies at Weston Jesuit School of Theology (currently Boston College), Massachusetts, USA.

She is also the editor of "Japan's Women Representatives" (in Japanese, Asahi Shimbun Shuppansha, 2016) and co-editor of "Gender Quotas in Comparative Perspectives: Understanding the Increase in Women Representatives" (in Japanese, Akashi Shoten, 2014).

Dr. Miura received the Wilma Rule Award (IPSA Award for the Best Research on Gender and Politics) in 2018 and was decorated as a Knight of the Order of Merit by the French government in 2021.
